## Woodrow Robert "Bob" Glass August 28, 1937—September 4, 2009

A funeral service for Woodrow Robert "Bob" Glass, 72, will be conducted at 11:00 A.M., Wednesday, September 9, 2009, at the United Church of Christ in Wheatland, Wyoming, with Reverend Jane Willis officiating. Inurnment will be in the Wheatland Cemetery with military rites accorded by Laramie Peak Post Veterans of Foreign Wars Post #3558 and Ora Call American Legion Post #10.

He died Friday, September 4, 2009, in the emergency room of the Platte County Memorial Hospital in Wheatland.

Bob was born August 28, 1937, in Bend, Oregon, to Woodrow N. and Ruby (Marriott) Horick. His parents divorced and Bob moved with his mother to Toledo, Ohio. Ruby remarried and Bob chose to be adopted by his step-father, Walter Glass. He attended Libbey High School.

Bob enlisted in the United States Air Force on



April 27, 1955. His basic training was at Lackland AFB, Texas and Tech School at Chanute AFB in Illinois. During his career, Bob was stationed in

South Carolina, Okinawa, Florida, The Netherlands, and Colorado. He was honorably discharged in July 1969. In 1971, Bob joined the Army National Guard and retired in 1980 with 23 years in the military.

He married Judy Brunner on August 2, 1958, while on leave in Toledo. Their daughter, Kelly was born in Charleston, South Carolina. The family traveled to Wyoming during a leave to visit family in Casper in 1969; and, fell in love with the area and decided to relocate. In 1976, the family moved to Wheatland. Bob retired from the Town of Wheatland in 2002 due to ill health.

Bob was an avid reader, sports trivia and history buff. He enjoyed hunting, fishing, cooking his famous Shrimp Gumbo, Spaghetti and "Uncle Bob's Baked Beans", drinking beer, old movies and musicals, spending time with his family and being "Grampy" to his only grandchild, Bre.

Survivors include his wife, Judy Glass of Wheatland; daughter, Kelly (John) Atterbury of Wheatland; a sister, Vera (Robert) Jones of Salt Lake City, Utah; and granddaughter, Bre Schindler of Moncks Corner, South Carolina.

He was preceded in death by his parents and an infant son, Douglas Edward Glass.
