GOODRICH, RHODA NOBLE July 24, 1843-July 27, 1924

With the death of Rhoda Noble Goodrich which occurred late Sunday night Wheatland lost one of its most respected tho most unassuming citizens.

Mrs. Goodrich was aged 81 years and three days at the time of her death. At an early age she moved to Indiana with her parents, and was married to Chauncey Goodrich at Larwill, Ind. on July 24, 1861. To this union were born three children, Chauncey Z. Goodrich of Wheatland, Charles W. Goodrich of Casper, and Mrs. Ella Jameson of Wheatland.

She moved to Fort Collins with her husband and children in 1886, coming from there to Wheatland in March, 1895.

She was the last survivor of a family of 10 children, all of whom who lived to a ripe old age. Her husband, Chauncey Goodrich, Sr., preceded her three years ago.

She had been ill for nine months before her death, bedfast most of the time, but bore her trial with the cheerful patience that marked her life.

The funeral was held Tuesday afternoon from the Methodist church followed by interment in the Wheatland cemetery.
