

HABEL, ROY
April 2, 1899-January 3, 1988

Roy Habel, 88, of Wheatland, died in Cheyenne on Jan. 3.

Services were held Wednesday in the Schrader-Prell Funeral Chapel in Wheatland. Chet Shaw, minister, officiated.

Interment was in Wheatland Cemetery.

Born April 2, 1899, in Shickley, Neb., Habel lived in the Wheatland area since 1938.

He married Marguerite Vogt in 1928 in Nebraska.

Habel sustained injuries during World War I, having served in the U.S. Army in France. Extensive hospitalization followed.

He operated a service station in Grand Island and Hastings prior to farming in the Wheatland area. Upon retiring in 1964, he moved into the city of Wheatland.

He was a member of the Platte County Farm Bureau, Disabled American Veterans and the V.F.W.

He is survived by his wife; a son and two daughters, Larry Habel of Modesto, Calif., Donna Johnston and Joan Coulthard of Wheatland; a brother and a sister, Harold and Stella Habel, both of Hastings; seven grandchildren and eight great-grandchildren.

He was preceded in death by his parents, John and Lula Habel; brothers and sister, Earl, Clifford, John and Alice.
