HAHN, CHARLES WILBUR April 29, 1891-October 20, 1936

A pall of sadness fell over the town Tuesday morning when it was learned that death had claimed Charles W. Hahn shortly after eight o'clock that morning at the Wheatland hospital.

For several months Mr. Hahn had been ill and only a few weeks ago returned from the Veterans hospital in Cheyenne greatly benefited and it was hoped would soon completely recover his health. The latter part of last week his condition became worse and Sunday he was taken to the hospital suffering from double pneumonia.

Mr. Hahn and his family came here from Haigler, Nebraska ten years ago this month when he purchased The Wheatland Times which he has since published. He was born in Frederick, Maryland April 29, 1891. He was a World War veteran and served overseas; was a member of the Legion; the Odd Fellows lodge and was a past president of the Lions club, and an honorary member of the fire department, and was active in all these orders until his health compelled him to give them up.

He is survived by his wife, two daughters and one son, Betty, 15, Marjorie, 13 and Dick, 12, and two brothers and one sister in Frederick, Maryland.

Funeral services will be held Friday at two o'clock from the First Methodist church, Rev. J.L. Williams officiating. Interment will be in the Wheatland cemetery.
