He was active in the Kiwanis Club and Trinity Lutheran Church and other boards and clubs in Sheridan. In his early years he enjoyed golfing, playing tennis, and fishing. His true love was his 1965 Mustang, and talking about old cars. In his retirement years he enjoyed traveling and going south for the winters.

He is survived by his three children and their spouses, Deanna and Lucien Trouchon of Wheatland, Alan and Susan Hall of Dallas, TX, and Gloria and Roy Moore of Casper; 12 grandchildren; and 14 great grandchildren.

He was preceded in death by his parents; his two wives; one brother; and one sister.
