Funeral Liturgy for Ronald Edward Havard, 47, were held Tuesday, Jan. 30, at 10 a.m. at Saint Patrick's Catholic Church in Wheatland with Father Jan Santich as the celebrant. He had worked for the Wheatland Coop Association for a number of years, then did contract labor for various people. He was working at Southfork Lumber at the time of his death. Engineer Unit in Wheatland; a member of the Knights of Columbus; the Moose Lodge; had been affiliated with Cub Scouts as part of the Troop Committee; active with his children's school activities; and enjoyed hunting, fishing and camping.

Ron is survived by his children, Amber Havard of Denver, Colo. and Lacy Havard and Jason Havard of Wheatland; mother, Kate Havard of Salem, S.D.; two brothers, Bobby Havard of Albany, Minn. and Jim Havard of Sioux Falls, S.D.; and two sisters, Pat Johnson of Omaha, Neb. and Mary Havard of Minneapolis, Minn.

He was preceded in death by his father, Robert Havard and a brother, Jerry Havard.
