

HENRYES, CLARENCE WALTER

October 18, 1885-May 17, 1960

The community was deeply saddened and shocked Tuesday to learn of the death of Clarence Walter Henryes, 74. Mr. Henryes died instantly from a self-inflicted gunshot wound in the head. He had been in ill health for some time and being despondent was the cause for the self-inflicted wound. A note was left to the family. There will be no inquest.

"Walt", as he was known in the community, was born October 18, 1885, in Watertown, Michigan, the son of Rev. Wm. and Abigale Leonard Henryes. He had made his home in Wheatland since 1947, coming here to open a café. Prior to coming here, he had lived in Michigan and Colorado. He married Ida Mae Thompson in Alpena, Mich., March 14, 1907.

His father was a Methodist minister as well as a physician.

Mr. Henryes was a life member of AF & AM No. 474, Detroit, Mich., and affiliated with the Methodist church.

He is survived by his wife; one daughter, Mrs. Viola Schneider, Wheatland; his grandchildren, Mrs. Darlene Williams, Glenrock, and Lowell Schneider, Wheatland; and four great grandsons.

Funeral services will be conducted from the Schrader Chapel, Friday, May 20, at 11 a.m. Rev Fred L. Stiegemiore officiating. Interment will be in the Wheatland cemetery with Masonic graveside services. Pallbearers will be Harold Garrett, Wm. Dannar, Paul Bullock, Wm. Sutherland, Ray Lamborn and J.A. Cole.
