Funeral services are being held from the Baptist church this afternoon at 2:30 with Rev. Chas. F. Thomas performing the last rites. Burial under the supervision of the Longwith-Richards Funeral Home will be in the Wheatland cemetery. Members of the Ora Call Post No. 10, American Legion, are acting as pallbearers.
