

Mrs. A. L. Hoffman,
Pioneer, Expires at
1:05 A. M. Wednesday

Funeral M. E. Church
At 3 O'clock
Sunday

Within two weeks after her sister,
Mrs. John A. Sanders of Long Beach,
Calif., passed away, Mrs. A. L. Hoff-
man, wife of County Commissioner A.
L. Hoffman, a resident of this vicinity
for thirty-three years succumbed to
infirmities which had confined her to
her bed for more than a year.

Mrs. Hoffman died at 1:05 a. m.,
Wednesday at the age of 69-years, and
her death marked the passing of
another of Platte county's highly re-
spected pioneers. For several months
it was known that Mrs. Hoffman's
condition was serious and that there
was little hope for her recovery. She
had become reconciled to the fact
that she could not long remain among
the living and patiently awaited the
end.

The deceased is survived by her
husband, two sons, Allie and Homer,
and two daughters, Mrs. O. L. Bridg-
mon and Mrs. Ray Sherwood. The
three former are residents of Wheat-
land and vicinity, while Mrs. Sher-
wood lives at Hallam, Nebr.

Funeral services will be held at the
M. E. church here at 3 p. m. Sunday,
conducted by Rev. H. E. Shepherd.
Burial will be made in the Wheatland
cemetery, with the Watson mortuary
in charge.
