## Dr. Billy LeMoyne Holmes

Funeral services for Dr. Billy LeMoyne Holmes, 81, were Tuesday, Dec. 2, at 10 a.m. at the Platte Funeral Chapel in Wheatland, with Reverend Les Ludlam of the United Methodist Church officiating, and services by the Independent Order of Oddfellows, Wheatland Paradise Lodge #29. Dr. Holmes died Friday, Nov. 28 at the Platte County Memorial Hospital in Wheatland.

His hobbies included coin and stamp collecting, reading, traveling, and collecting clocks. He was n avid bowler and football fan. He was a devoted husband and father.
