## HUGGINS, LEROY November 22, 1912-1932

The funeral of LeRoy Huggins who was instantly killed Friday, when the truck he was driving overturned on Guard Hill, ten miles south of Chugwater, was held in the Congregation church here Sunday afternoon with Rev. Calvert of Fort F.E. Warren in charge. Friends from Slater and Chugwater came in large numbers.

LeRoy Huggins was born in Colfax, Washington, November 22<sup>nd</sup>, 1912, being nineteen years, eleven months and six days old at the time of his death. He graduated from Chugwater high school in the class of 1930. He was well loved by all who knew him. He is survived by his parents, Mr. and Mrs. L.S. Huggins, two brothers, Dale and Harold and other relatives. Six of his boy friends acted as pallbearers. Burial was made in the Wheatland cemetery with the Copley Funeral Home service at the grave.
