

HURST, HOWARD DAVID

July 11, 1888-May 13, 1961

Howard David Hurst, 72, passed away in Memorial Hospital, Casper May 13, 1961 after an extended illness. He was born in Silver Creek, Nebr., July 11, 1888 and had been a resident of Wheatland for the past 57 years.

Mr. Hurst was a retired post office custodian, a member of IOOF, VFW, and American Legion, having been commander of the local post, and also past adjutant of the state VFW organization. He was a World War I veteran and a long time member of the Methodist church.

He is survived by his wife Gladys and one sister, Mrs. Rebecca Blue of Sacramento, Calif.
