

Eva "Dutchie" Huston

Eva "Dutchie" Huston died at the age of 82 May 14, 1979 at DePaul Hospital in Cheyenne.

Dutchie was born December 12, 1896 in Golden, Colorado. She moved with her family from Golden to Denver and worked in the family boarding house.

In Denver she married Henry Miller, a city fireman. Henry passed away several years later.

Dutchie met and married Curly Huston in 1942. They lived in Denver during the winter months and stayed in the Slater area during the summer. Curly passed away in 1967. After his death, she moved to the home, which she owned in Wheatland.
