

INGALLS, CLELL E.  
September 9, 1933-August 2, 1953

Mr. and Mrs. Scott Ingalls of Wheatland received the sad news on Monday evening of this week of the death of their son, Clell, who had been stationed in Hawaii with the U.S. Marine Air Corps. The telegram from the Navy department did not give the details, but stated that young Ingalls died on Sunday August 2 as a result of a motorcycle accident, at Oahu, Hawaii.

Clell had been in the service two years, and only recently had arrived in Hawaii where he was serving as dental technician with the marine corps. His work consisted of assisting with the return of the wounded from Korea.

A graduate of the Wheatland high school with the Class of 1951, Clell was also a past chancellor of the Wheatland De Molay chapter. Born in Thermopolis on September 9, 1933, he had lived in Wheatland since 1938.

Left to mourn his passing are his parents, Mr. and Mrs. Scott Ingalls; his grandmothers, Mrs. Winifred Shafer of Casper and Mrs. Ada B. Leonard of Moorehead, Minn.; and a host of friends.

The date for the funeral services has not been set, pending arrival of the body, which is being returned to Denver by plane. Schraders will bring the remains to Wheatland for burial, which will probably take place the first part of next week.

Rev. Kale King will officiate at the services and casket bearers will be Harold Rumsey, Bernard Rumsey, Willot Rhoades, Buddy Nye, Marvin Hopkins and Melvin Qualls.
