

IRVINE, WILLIAM
1861-June 14, 1948

Local men attending the funeral of W.C. Irvine, which was held from the Masonic Temple in Cheyenne Tuesday were George Mitchell, E.M. Yates, J. A. Elliot, T.A. Shaw and J.C. Shaw of Orin.

The remains lay in state at the temple from 12 until 2 p.m. Senator John B. Kendrick, a close friend and business associate of Irvine for 40 years, made a short address at the funeral.

Mr. Irvine was second to none in his large acquaintanceship over Wyoming, and his intimate connection with all phases of the development of the state. He served as president of the Wyoming Stockgrowers' Association, and finally for 20 years as treasurer of the association, having been re-elected at the annual convention held here last June, although too sick to attend.
