

JACKSON, ANTHONY BEAU
August 17, 1976-June 12, 1994

A Wheatland youth died Sunday morning at the Wyoming Medical Center in Casper, following a one vehicle accident south of Douglas several hours earlier.

Anthony Beau Jackson, 17, was a passenger in a vehicle driven by Quent Juschka, 18, also of Wheatland.

The second passenger in the vehicle was Dennis Willis, 17, of Wheatland.

According to Wyoming Highway Patrolman, Al Lesco, of Douglas, Juschka was headed south on I-25 about 1:45 a.m. At mile marker 133, the WHP said Juschka swerved to avoid a carcass of a bull elk which had been struck by another vehicle.

The Juschka vehicle went into the median, where it rolled two times, ejecting both Juschka and Jackson. The WHP said Juschka and Jackson were thrown into the northbound lanes of I-25.

Juschka was hospitalized and was listed in "critical but stable" condition.

The WHP said seatbelts were installed on the 1985 Jeep Cherokee Juschka was driving, but said they were not in use at the time of the accident.

Jackson was the son of Doug and Cindy Jackson of Wheatland. His father is a junior high instructor and an assistant coach for Wheatland High School.
