

**KAHLER, KAY MARIE MONTGOMERY**

**August 17, 1926-October 11, 1975**

Funeral services for Mrs. Kay Marie Kahler (Montgomery) will be held Wednesday, October 15, 1975 at 2:00 p.m. from the First Baptist Church in Wheatland with the Rev. Douglas J. Neumann officiating. Burial will be at the Wheatland Cemetery.
