

KAMPSI, HILJA AUGUSTA KETTULA
November 5, 1883-November 22, 1961

Hilja Augusta Kamps, 78, passed away November 22, 1961, following an extended illness. Having come to Wyoming in 1901, she resided in Cumberland from 1906 to 1930 and in Superior from 1930 to 1951, moving to Wheatland 10 years ago.

Born in Finland on November 5, 1883 to Matt and Mary Kaki Kettula, she was a member of the Finnish Lutheran church. She was united in marriage to Charles Kamps in Cumberland on October 31, 1906.
