Long-time local banker dies

Andrew L. Kendig, a leader in Wheatland's banking community for nearly a half-century, died Nov. 22 after a brief illness.

A Missouri native, Kendig was one of the founders of Farmers State Bank of Burns and served that bank until he became manager of the Regional Agricultural Credit Corporation of Cheyenne in 1933. In 1938 he moved to Wheatland and the State Bank of Wheatland and oversaw operations there until he retired as President and Chairman of the Board two years ago.

He was a past president of the Wyoming Bankers Association, a member of the Wheatland Lions Club and the American Legion, and a 32nd Degree member and one of the founders of the Burns Masonic Temple and a member of the Korein Temple of the Shrine.

Funeral services were held Tuesday
