Francis P. Kenney, age 86, who resided 14 miles southeast of Wheatland, passed away yesterday, March 16, at a local hospital where he had been a patient for several weeks. Mr. Kenney was a retired farmer.

Born in Yorkshire, England, January 1, 1869, Mr. Kenney went to Germany in 1883 and there received his education. He farmed in Florida for twenty years before coming to Wyoming, where he homesteaded in Platte county in 1912. He became a naturalized citizen of the United States on February 1, 1916.

Mr. Kenney never married. Of a large family of some thirteen brothers and sisters, only one brother, Ralph Kenney of Waterford, Canada, survives.

Funeral services will be held Saturday morning at ten o'clock at the Schrader chapel with interment in the Wheatland cemetery.
