

HENRY S. KLASSERT 1787

Funeral services for Henry Klassert, 79, who died Sept. 10 in Cheyenne were held Thursday, Sept. 13 at 10:30 a.m. with Dan Barcus officiating.

Klassert was born Oct. 15, 1904 in Wheatland, the son of Samuel and Maude Klassert. He was raised in and around the Wheatland area.

He married Ogilvy Miritz February of 1926. In 1934 they moved to Gering, Neb. where he farmed until 1942 when he entered the U.S. Army. After being discharged, he returned to Gering and remained there until 1973 at which time he returned to Wheatland.

Survivors include one brother, Loren of Mitchell, Neb., and two sisters, Lorena Gustin and Juanita Groskopf, both of Gering.

He was preceded in death by his parents, his wife and a sister.
