

KUEHNER, GODFREY HENRY
June 26, 1869-December 4, 1950

Funeral services for Godfrey Kuehner, 81, will be held Friday at 2 p.m. in the Christian Church with Mr. C.E. Henry officiating.

Kuehner, born in South Webster, Ohio, June 26m 1869, died in the Wheatland General hospital December. 4, after a week's stay. He had been a resident of Wheatland Since 1900.

Before entering the grocery business from which he had been retired for some time, he had worked as a miner in Colorado and Montana for 13 years. He was a member of the Odd Fellows lodge for 55 years and had been presented with a 50-year medal from the organization. He was affiliated with the Christian Church.
