

LACK, JOSEPH H.

January 8, 1892-April 17, 1945

Joseph H. Lack, 51, of Guernsey, resident of this county since 1915, passed away at the Veteran's hospital in Cheyenne at 9:15 p.m. Tuesday, April 17, following a two-week stay.

Funeral services will be held Saturday in the Methodist church in Wheatland with the Rev. W.W. Maxwell officiating. Interment will be in the Wheatland cemetery, and the local American Legion will have charge of the military graveside services.

Mr. Lack was born in Chariton, Ia., January 8, 1892 and has been employed by the U.S. Reclamation service in Guernsey for the past few years. He is a member of the Wheatland Odd Fellows lodge, V.F.W., American Legion and the A.O.U.W.

Besides his wife, Alice, he is survived by one son, Cletis, at home; four daughters, Mrs. Josephine Blummer of Wendover, Marilyn of Cheyenne, and Katharine and Mildred at home; one brother, David Lack of Ft. Laramie; two sisters, Mrs. Eora Davenspike of Ft. Laramie and Mrs. Emma Loomis of Basin; and two grandchildren.

The body will lie in state at the Schrader Funeral home until time for the services Saturday.
