Mr. Lamborn, a resident of Wheatland since 1948, died Friday, May 21, at the Platte County Memorial Hospital in Wheatland.

Raymond Lamborn was born in Bennet, Neb., May 6, 1912, the son of Paul

and Florence (Dunlap) Lamborn. He married Ethyl Chandler on July 9, 1933, in Bennet after his graduation from the University of Nebraska. Mr. Lamborn worked at the Remington Arms Plant in Denver during World War II; was store manager for Firestone Tire and Rubber in Scottsbluff and Rapid City.

Later he was district sales manager with Firestone, traveling South Dakota and Wyoming. In 1948, he purchased Wheatco Refinery in Wheatland, making many friends of his customers and competitors. He sold his business in 1978.

Mr. Lamborn was a member of the United Church of Christ in Wheatland; a Master Mason of Wyoming A.F. and A.M. #16; past president of the Wyoming Retail Merchants Association; and

served on the Employment Securities Commission from 1969-1975. The county commissioners appointed him to be on the board during the construction of the Platte County Memorial Hospital and he served as secretary from 1961-1963 and as president from 1963-1966. He was active in local and state politics as an avid republican. He was a 17-year member of the "Jolly Boys", a men's bridge group. In retirement, Mr. Lamborn and his wife, Ethyl, became snowbirds, spending the winters in Borrego Springs, Calif. During this time, he made over 150 perfectly tuned wind chimes for friends and family. Mr. Lamborn was known for his generosity, good humor and unsolicited advice to married couples to tell each other "I love you" every day. He was preceded in death by his beloved wife

of 63 years in 1996.
