Noble, the year old son of Mr. and Mrs. A.G. Locke, met death by drowning Monday afternoon at the Joe Wilde ranch on Laramie river, near Ft. Laramie, where Mr. and Mrs. Locke moved several weeks ago to accept a position. The little child had wandered from the house in search of its father, who had left the house a short time before to feed a bunch of cows across the river, and fell into the icy waters of the river while attempting to cross the steam.

A water hole had been cut in the ice to afford water for the stock, and the little child fell into the stream at this point. A search for the body of the child was started, but it was not recovered until Tuesday morning, when the remains were brought to the Pepper Mortuary at Wheatland and prepared for burial.

Funeral services were held yesterday morning at 10:30 at the Methodist church, interment being in the Wheatland cemetery.
