

LLOYD, OSCAR  
1907-September 11, 1941

Oscar Lloyd, of Guernsey, was found this morning at 4 a.m. by a train crew, with his head completely severed and one arm also cut off.

It is believed Lloyd crawled onto the rails between the car wheels before that time as a train was waiting on the tracks behind the depot at Guernsey. There was no indication of the accident until the body was discovered.

Lloyd had been associated with Otto Herman of Wendover. The remains were brought to Wheatland by the Watson and Dennis Funeral Home, where funeral arrangements have not yet been completed.
