## LUTZKE, JEANETTE WELTY March 30, 1889-July 24, 1977

Chugwater pioneer, Jeanette Lutzke, died Sunday, July 24, 1977 at the age of 88 at the Platte County Memorial Hospital. She was born in Zwingle, Iowa, March 30, 1889 and came to the Iowa Flats area with her family when they homesteaded there in 1909. Here she met and married Ernest Lutzke December 30, 1913. He had also homestead here with his parents.

She and Ernest continued to farm and ranch on his parent's original homestead until his death in June of 1975. Since his death, she had made her home with her daughter, Jane Lutzke, in Buffalo.

Funeral services were held Tuesday, July 26, 1977 at the Schrader-Prell Chapel with Rev. Charles Clough of Chugwater officiating. Mrs. Lutzke was laid to rest in the Wheatland Cemetery.
