

MRS. SIDNEY MAGEE PASSES AWAY SUNDAY AFTER LONG ILLNESS

Mrs. Nellie Clark Magee, wife of Sidney W. Magee, passed away at her home in the north part of Wheatland Sunday afternoon, after an illness of long duration. Mrs. Magee underwent an operation on her head a short time ago and while recovering from this she was stricken with stomach ailment. She was confined to her bed for about two weeks before the end.

Funeral services were held Wednesday afternoon at the Methodist church. Rev. D. M. Kitch performed the final rites - and burial was made in the Wheatland cemetery with the Lyla Watson Funeral Home in charge of arrangements. Pall bearers were members of the Wheatland Fire Department, of which organization Mr. Magee has been a member for years.

The deceased was born September 6 1900, in Morganton, North Carolina. She came to this part of Wyoming in 1917 to make her home with her aunt and uncle, Mr. and Mrs. Chas. Wilson, well known ranchers of the North Laramie river district. Since that time she has lived in or near Wheatland.

Besides her husband and aunt and uncle, she is survived by four brothers Bratcher, Lee, Lewis and Plato Clark, all of North Carolina; three sisters, Mrs. Callie Fox, Mrs. Mary Lou Abee and Mrs. Nannie Burnes, also of North Carolina, a niece, Ruth Clark and step mother, Mrs. James Clark of Morganton, N. C.
