Funeral services for Georgia Barbara Marker, 82, were held Wednesday, June 26 at 2 p.m. at the Platte Funeral Chapel in Wheatland, with Pastor Gordon Swedberg officiating. Interment was in the Wheatland Cemetery.

Mrs. Marker died Monday, June 24 at the Platte County Memorial Hospital in Wheatland.

She was born November 5, 1913, in Milligan, Neb., to Emil and Barbara (Herynk) Kassik. Georgia was reared and educated in Milligan and Graduated from high school there. Oct. 10, 1936, she married Carl E. Marker in David City, Neb.

They lived in Rising City, Neb., for a time before moving to Wheatland in the fall of 1940 for a change in climate.

They lived for a short time in Cheyenne, Wyo., during the war years where Mr. Marker was employed at a modification center for modifying the B-51's. Later they returned to Wheatland where Georgia lived until the time of her death.

She enjoyed her flowers and her animals. Georgia was a regular caller for the radio "Birthday Club."

Georgia is survived by two children, Gene Marker and Barbara Call both of Wheatland; four grandchildren; and three great grandchildren. She was preceded in death by her parents; her husband on Feb. 11, 1977; four brothers, Ed, Ruby, Albert and Emil Kassik; and a sister, Josie Krejdl.
