Clem A. McAuley

Clem A. McAuley, 94, died Sunday, Oct. 4, 1981 at the Platte County Memorial Hospital Nursing

Wing.

He was born May 3, 1887 in Statesville, N.C., the son of E.R. and Martha McAuley. Clem was raised and educated on the family farm in Statesville and came to Wyoming in 1909 where he began working on the Hall and Bowie Ranch. He and Sallie Houts were married May 1, 1915 in Cheyenne.

The couple returned to Clem's homestead in Palmer Canyon. Sallie died in January 1973 and Clem continued to work on his ranch until November 1980 when ill health confined him to the

nursing wing in Wheatland.

He is survived by one son, Charles of Wheatland; two brothers, Archie of Wheatland and J.O. McAuley of Statesville, N.C.; as well as five grand-children and 10 great-grandchildren. He was preceded in death by his parents, wife, and two brothers.

Services will be held at the United Methodist Church in Wheatland Thursday Oct. 8 at 2 p.m. The Rev. John Bailey of the United Presbyterian Church in Guernsey will officiate. Burial will be in the Wheatland Cemetery.
