MCCALL, JAMES WILLIAM October 24, 1879-July 1, 1925

The funeral of J.W. McCall was held at 2:30 P.M. yesterday, July 8, from the Methodist church, having been delayed one day when the Santa Fe train bearing the funeral party arrived too late in Denver to make connections with the Colorado and Southern for Wheatland.

James William McCall was born in Carbondale, Kas., on Oct. 24, 1879, being 49 years, 8 months and 7 days at the time of his death on July 1. He was married on Oct. 24, 1900 to Rebecca Finn, who passed on five years ago. To this union were born a daughter, Marie, who lived only 7 months, and two sons, Francis and Fred of La Junta, Colo., who survive. Mr. McCall was again married to Anna Mann on June 6, 1923, who survives him. He is also survived by one grandson, two brothers and one sister.

Mr. McCall lived for a number of years south of Wheatland on the farm now owned by O.A. Knight, selling the property and leaving soon after the death of his first wife. He is remembered by his old friends as an upright man and a pleasant neighbor. Many of his old friends here attended to pay their last respects to the deceased.
