## MCCARTNEY, THOMAS JOEL November 20, 1938-January 5, 2000

Funeral services for Thomas Joel McCartney, 61, were held Tuesday, January 11, 2000 at 2 p.m. at the Church of Christ of Latter Day Saints with Bishop Myron Singleton conducting the services and Mac Hazel as the Eulogist.
