MCFARLAND, CLARA RAYMONDA July 30, 1931-July 13, 1950

Funeral services were held Sunday at the Methodist church in Wheatland for Clara Raymonda McFarland, daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Sam McFarland of Parma, Ida., who died of injuries received in a fall Thursday evening, July 13.

She is survived by her parents, Mr. and Mrs. Sam McFarland of Parma, Ida.; two sisters, Mrs. Fern Har (garbled print in newspaper), and one brother, Carl McFarland of Weiser, Ida.

Pallbearers were Don Wickam, Carl Preuit, Dean Ryff, Donald Ryff, Gene Perkins, and Raymond Henke. The Rev. Howard Rico officiated at the last rites and interment was in the Wheatland cemetery.

Local arrangements were in charge of the Schrader Funeral Home.

An inquest held Monday afternoon in connection with the death July 13 of Clara Raymonda McFarland, 18, authorities held the cause of death was accidental.

According to County Coroner Ted Schrader, Clara McFarland, Carolyn O'Dell, and Ella Anderson were riding in the back of the truck driven by Dean Gray when Miss McFarland slipped off the back end of the truck and fell to the pavement last Thursday evening.

Dean Gray and Ted Diehl, Gray's companion, testified they were traveling at a low rate of speed when Miss McFarland fell. Investigating authorities found no indication or reckless driving or speeding.

Occupants of the car were traveling south on highway 87 when the accident occurred.

Following the accident, Gray and Diehl brought Miss McFarland to the Wheatland General hospital where she died ten minutes later of skull fracture, shock and other compound fractures.
