

MCGILL, MERVYN MERVIS
September 4, 1922-May 24, 1934

Mervyn Merle McGill, son of Mr. and Mrs. J.A. McGill, formerly of Greystocks, was buried Sunday in the Wheatland cemetery, having died on Friday in Las Vegas, while the family were en route to their home here.

Mr. and Mrs. McGill and their two sons left last summer for Phoenix to try the climate there for Mr. McGill's health, who was suffering from lung trouble as a result of injuries received in the World War. When the boy was taken seriously ill, he expressed a wish to return to the homestead, and the family set out by train.

They were met here by W.F. Brown who took them to their home at Greystocks. Rev. Paxton conducted the funeral there Sunday morning, Misses Koreen Booth and Ruth Wickham accompanied him there and assisted in the song service.

The boy was aged two years and eight months at the time of his death.
