

Edna Warre McGuire

Funeral Liturgy for Edna Marie McGuire, 90, was conducted at 10 a.m., Monday, May 1 at Saint Patrick Catholic Church in Wheatland, with Father Jan Santich as the celebrant. Vigil for the Deceased was conducted at 7 p.m., Sunday, April 30 at Saint Patrick Catholic Church. Interment was in the Wheatland Cemetery.

She died Friday, April 28, 2006, at the Platte County Memorial Nursing Home in Wheatland.

Edna was born July 15, 1915, in Lansing, Iowa, the daughter of Frances (Thornton) and Thomas Francis Murphy. She was reared and educated in Lansing and in 1931 married Bernard Raymond McGuire. After a few years in Iowa, they moved to Wheatland in 1933 and farmed on various farms on the Wheatland Flats until 1948 when they purchased the Muleshoe Ranch. Edna's entire life was devoted to her family and working on the ranch. She was a devout Catholic and was a member of Saint Patrick Catholic Church and Council of Catholic Women.
