

## James Henry McGuire

Mass for Christian Burial for Tames Henry McGuire, 88, will be held today (Saturday, Nov. 20, 1993) at 1 p.m., at the Saint Patrick's Catholic Church in Wheatland, with Father Joseph Fraher as the Celebrant. Vigil for the Deceased was held Friday, Nov. 19, 1993, at 7 p.m. at Saint Patrick's Catholic Church. Interment will follow today's service in the Wheatland Cemetery.

Mr. McGuire died Tuesday, Nov. 16, 1993 at the Platte County Memorial Hospital Nursing Home in Wheatland. He was born Nov. 10, 1905 in Lansing, Iowa, the son of James and Katherine (Burns) McGuire. He received his early education in Iowa.

In 1918, he moved with his family to Wheatland, and worked on the family farm. He married Marcella Kernan on Nov. 10, 1933 in Wexford, near Lansing, Iowa. They moved to Wheatland the last of April, 1934, and Mr. McGuire was a tenant farmer and rancher until his retirement in the early 1970s. He was a member of St. Patrick's Catholic Church.

He is survived by his wife, Marcella, of Wheatland, and eight sons and two daughters, Francis McGuire, Martin McGuire, Joe McGuire, Gene McGuire and Willie McGuire, all of Wheatland, Jim McGuire of Chugwater, Harry McGuire of Glendo and Charles McGuire of Torrington, and Celia Enniss of Wheatland and Mary Norred of Breckenridge, Tex. Twenty-three grandchildren and 16 great-grandchildren also remain.

He was preceded in death by his parents, three brothers, two sisters and two sons, Mike and Eddie McGuire.

Serving as pallbearers will be his sons, Francis McGuire, Jim McGuire, Martin McGuire, Joe McGuire, Harry McGuire, Gene McGuire and Willie McGuire.
