

MCLEAN, EVA LENA TROYER

August 1, 1878-April 22, 1932

Mrs. Eva Lena McLean, 54, wife of Wm. McLean of the Bordeaux vicinity and one of the early day settlers of that community, passed away in Wheatland, Friday, April 22<sup>nd</sup>. Mrs. McLean had been ill for the past year and during the last eight months of her life, she was confined to bed.

The deceased was born in LaGrange, Ind., August 1, 1878, and came to this part of Wyoming with her parents, Mr. and Mrs. A.B. Troyer, in the nineties. Her father, who at that time, was employed by the Two Bar ranch, and Mrs. McLean has lived in that section since that time.

She was married to William McLean on July 17, 1900. To this union, one daughter, Mary, was born. She is survived by her husband and daughter, also by her father, who now resides in Gering, Nebr.; one brother, Willis of LaGrange, Wyo.; and five sisters.: Mrs. Emma Weatherwax of Wheatland, Mrs. Lizzie Smith of Dwyer, Mrs. Pearl Griesser of Underwood, Iowa, Mrs. Cora Dickerson of Chariton, Iowa, and Mrs. Nettie White of Chariton, Iowa. Her mother died 17 years ago and was buried in the Wheatland cemetery.

Funeral services were held at the Congregational church Sunday afternoon. Rev. R.E. Morgan preached the funeral sermon. Interment took place in the Wheatland cemetery with the Copley Funeral Home in charge of arrangements.
