Services for Paul N. Mers, 80, who died in Wheatland Oct. 29 were held in the United Church of Christ, Nov. 1 at 2:00 P.M. with Pastor Delbert Dick officiating.

Mers was born May 30, 1905, in Kings Point, Missouri, the son of Andrew and Lela Asher Mers. He spent his early childhood in the Goshen Hole area where his parents homesteaded.

He served with the Armed Forces during World War II and later worked making orthopedic limbs in Denver, western Nebraska and Cheyenne. After his retirement he worked in Laramie and Platte Co. as a farmer.

He is survived by a daughter, Jean Ryan of Mercedes, Texas, by four grandchildren and many other relatives and friends.
