METHER, THOMAS ?-July 24-1948

Alvin W. Miller of Wheatland has been accused on involuntary manslaughter in the hit-and-run accident which occurred last summer near Guernsey, according to the County Attorney. Miller was arrested Monday by the highway patrolman and the county sheriff, and has been released on bond.

The preliminary hearing has been set for Dec. 14th.

The victim of the accident was Tom Mether, about 60, who was instantly killed the evening of July 24th. He was walking toward Guernsey on the left hand side of the highway, facing traffic when hit by the car. His body was found off the highway in a driveway, 51 feet from the point of impact.

Mether had arrived that day from Rock Springs to work as a section hand for the CB & Q railroad. He is survived by his wife and two daughters of Sidney, Nebraska.

It is understood that the FBI may be called on for technical aid with evidence in the case.
