

**MILLER, CHARLES AUGUSTA**

**March 2, 1882-April 2, 1965**

Pioneer rancher, Charles Augusta (Gus) Miller succumbed in the Platte County Memorial Hospital on April 2, 1965 at the age of 83. Mr. Miller was born in Greeley, Colo. March 2, 1882 and came to this area at the age of 14 months when his family settled on the present Miller ranch. He was in the Livery Stable business with Louie Cook in 1911 and 1912. In 1920, he married Ruth M. Martin in Cheyenne.

Mr. Miller was a member of the Wyoming Stock Growers Assn., the Laramie Peak Stock Growers Assn., AF & AM No. 23 and Order of Eastern Star. He was a 50-year member of the Masonic Lodge.

Last rites were conducted by Rev. Clare E. Olney at the United Church of Christ on April. 5 at 2:00 p.m. Masonic graveside services were held by the Chugwater Lodge at the Wheatland cemetery.
