MILLER, EFFIE MAY July 29, 1877-March 6, 1929

The entire community was shocked to learn Tuesday of the sudden death of Mrs. Jim Miller, wife of one of Wheatland's best known ranchers for the past 16 years. Mrs. Miller had not been in the best of health for some time and they recently held one of the largest sales of the year on the Tisch ranch and were living in the Chas Huntzinger home in the west part of town, preparing to leave for Oregon in a short time because of Mrs. Miller's health. Mrs. Miller passed away Tuesday evening from heart failure.

Mrs. Effie May Miller was born in Indianapolis, Ind., July 29, 1877, being 54 years of age at the time of her death. The Miller family came to this section of Wyoming from Missouri 16 years ago and lived on the Manning place northwest of Wheatland for 7 years then moved to the Tisch ranch where they lived until last month. Mrs. Miller leaves to mourn her passing, her husband, Jim Miller, one daughter, Mrs. Ira Bell, four sons, Earl, Carl and Everet of Wheatland and Lon of Seattle, Wash. The arrangements for the funeral are not definitely decided, but if their son, Lon, arrives in time, it will be held at the Christian church Saturday afternoon and if he does not arrive in time, they will hold the service at the Christian church Sunday. Burial will be made in the Wheatland cemetery.
