

Services for Henry Mills, 71, who died May 6, 1986 in Wheatland, were held Saturday May 10, 1986, at 2:00 P.M. in the United Church of Christ with the Rev. James Vuocolo officiating.

Born Aug. 30, 1914 in Dewitt, Neb., Henry Mills was the son of Jacob and Mary Mills. When he was small he moved with his family to Wellington,

Colo. and later to Loveland, Colo.

In 1930 he came to Wheatland with his family and farmed with his father until he and Esther Wagner were married, Jan. 30, 1937. He then operated his own farm and dairy west of town until ill health forced his retirement in 1970.

He was a member of the United Church of

Christ.

Besides his wife, Esther, of Wheatland, he is survived by two daughters: Marjorie Stumbough and Barbara Swan, both of Wheatland, two brothers: Herman Mills of Boise, Idaho, Ronald Mills of Wichita, Kan., two sisters: Lydia Frick of Ft. He was preceded in death by his parents, two

brothers and two sisters.
