

MILLS, WILLIAM HENRY

1862-April 1, 1945

Funeral services will be held Sunday in the Christian church at 2 p.m. for William H. Mills, who died in a San Diego, Calif. hospital on April 1, following a short illness. Mr. James Cameron will officiate at the services. The body will arrive from San Diego Saturday and will lie in state at the Schrader chapel until time for the services.

William Henry Mills, 82, was born in Henry county, Ind., and has been a resident of this community for the past 34 years. He had been making his home with his son, S.R. Mills, until he went to San Diego for a visit with his daughter, Mrs. Olive Van Dine in San Diego. He was affiliated with the local Christian church.

He is survived by three sons, Roger and Luther of Wheatland and John of Anderson, Ind.; two daughters, Mrs. Ruth Wyman of Gig Harbor, Wash., and Mrs. Van Dine of San Diego; two brothers, one sister, 17 grandchildren and 20 great grandchildren.

Burial will be in the Wheatland cemetery beside his wife who preceded him in death in 1925.
