MORRIS, ROBERT 1884-June 14, 1963

Robert Morris took a homestead north of Wheatland in 1913, residing in this area until 1923 when he moved to Wendover. He lived in Guernsey two years before moving to Lingle where he made his home until 1962. He then moved to Torrington. Death occurred June 14, 1963 in the Colorado General Hospital in Denver. He was born in Haddam, Kans. in 1884 to Milton and Charity Morris.

Services were held June 18, 1963 at 2:00 p.m. at the Guernsey Community Church. Rev. Cliff Polson conducted the last rites with interment in the Wheatland cemetery.
