Services for Anne Morrison

Services for Mrs. Anne Morrison were held at the Schrader Chapel January 11, 1964, at 2: p. m. with Rev. Donald Mills officiating. Burial was in the Wheatland cemetery.

Mrs. Morrison, who was born in Oak Park, Illinois, July 9, 1892 to Mr. and Mrs. Marion Miller, succumbed at Tucson, Ariz. while visiting her daughter. The deceased was a resident of Wheatland from 1907 until 1925, after which she made her home in Morris, Ill. She was a member of the Presbyterian Church and OES.

Survivors include a son, Milton Carroll Morrison of Washington, D. C.; daughter, Mrs. Edward Brown, Tucson, Ariz.; half-brother, Frank Hutchinson of Houston, Texas; a sister Mrs. Emogene Hansen of Tucson and four grand-children. Her husband Milton C. Morrison, preceded her in death in 1938.

Mr. Morrisons grandparents, Mr and Mrs. Caldwell Morrison were the first settlers on the Wheatland Flats in 1885 and were charter members of the Congregational Church. Mrs Caldwell Morrison also had the distinction of being the first baker and volunteer fireman in this community. She baked forty loaves of bread a day for the men working for the Wyoming Development Co. Their son Milton was the first child born here.
