MULLEN, JAMES AUGUSTUS December 22, 1888-December 5, 1955

The body of James Augustus Mullen was discovered in his home by his nephew, Jack Mullen, last Sunday morning, December 18. The deceased was last seen alive December 4. His mail had not been gathered since December 5. An autopsy revealed that death was due to natural causes.

Mr. Mullen was born December 22, 1888 at the Mullen ranch near Wheatland, the son of Michael and Sarah Donally Mullen, and was 66 years of age at the time of his death. He was a retired rancher and a member of the Catholic church and the Veterans of Foreign Wars.

Survivors include one brother, Patrick Mullen of Wheatland and several nieces and nephews.

Funeral services were held at the St. Patrick's church in Wheatland Tuesday morning at 9 o'clock with Father Thomas Aeschbacher officiating. Rosary services were held at the Schrader chapel Monday evening at 8.

Burial was in the Wheatland cemetery with military honors at the graveside, the deceased being a veteran of World War I. Pallbearers were Pat McGuire, Leo Kernan, George Grant, John Mylet, Joe Ferguson and William Howard.
