## MURPHY, JOSEPH DELBERT January 6, 1921-July 19, 1989

Mass for Christian Burial for Joseph Delbert Murphy, age 68, was held Saturday, July 22, 1989 at the St. Patrick's Catholic Church in Wheatland with the Celebrant Father Malcolm Reid.
