

Charles (Chuck) Clement McAuley

June 20, 1916 - April 28, 1991

Funeral service for Charles (Chuck) Clement McAuley, 74, were held Friday, May 3 at 2 p.m. at the First United Methodist Church in Wheatland, with Rev. Susan D. Phifer and Pastor Tim Ricker of Calvary Baptist Church in Douglas officiating.

Mr. McAuley died Sunday, April 28 at the Platte County Memorial Hospital in Wheatland following an extended illness.

He was born June 20, 1916 in Wheatland, the son of Clement Alexander and Sallie (Houts) McAuley. He was reared and educated in the Wheatland area. He was a lifelong rancher and enjoyed the sport of rodeo.

He served in the Army Air Corps during World War II. He was a member of the Wyoming Stock Growers Association, the Moose Lodge and Rodeo Cowboy Association.

He is survived by five children, Fred of Lusk, Ed, Dick, Jim and Sallie May, all of Wheatland, and 12 grandchildren. He was preceded in death by his parents, Sallie and Clem McAuley, and his uncle, E.A. (Archie) McAuley.
