

Everett Eugene Nagel

February 23, 1928 – March 16, 2009

A funeral service for Everett Eugene Nagel, 81, was conducted at 2:00 P.M., Friday, March 20, 2009, at the First Christian Church in Wheatland, Wyoming, with Pastor Andy Gudahl officiating. Interment with military rites accorded by Ora Call American Legion Post #10 and Laramie Peak Veterans of Foreign Wars Post #3558 was in the Wheatland Cemetery.

He died Monday, March 16, 2009, at the Cheyenne Regional Medical Center in Cheyenne, Wyoming.

Everett was born February 23, 1928, in Lincoln, Nebraska, the son of John and Amelia (Litt) Nagel. He was raised in the Scottsbluff, Nebraska area. Everett joined the United States Navy and served from October 23, 1945 to February 18, 1949. Upon his honorable discharge, he returned to work in Scottsbluff. Through a mutual friend, he met his wife, Gladys Ruth (Wilhelm) and they were married July 12, 1952 in Wheatland. In 1957, he moved his family to Vallejo, California where he worked for a dairy company. They returned to Wheatland in 1965 and he farmed with his wife's uncle for a year before purchasing their own farm on Hightower Road. In August of 2008, Everett moved into town. His life was farming.

Survivors include his daughters, Karen (Chris) Laursen of Thornton, Colorado and Pamela (Mike) Harris of Wheatland; three grandchildren, Candice (John) Hultman of Casper, Wyoming, Sean (Ashley) Harris of Wheatland, and Larry Wickam of Laramie, Wyoming; two great grandchildren, London and Talon Hultman of Casper; special friend, Clara Parker of Wheatland; eight siblings; Calvin Nagel of Story, Wyoming, Murray Nagel of Vancouver, Washington, Allen "Sonny" Nagel of San Pablo, California, Irene Ruppel of Scottsbluff, Nebraska, Darlene Thompson of Glendo, Wyoming, Sharon "Annie" Kreiling of Springfield, Missouri, Carol Worth of Gering, Nebraska and Linda Johnson of Scottsbluff, Nebraska.

He was preceded in death by his parents; his wife, on October 31, 1985; two brothers, Marvin and Raymond Nagel; and one sister, Judith Pamela Nagel.
