

NASH, DELLA MAE PARADISE
September 3, 1890-July 23, 1973

Della Mae Nash, 82, passed away on Monday, July 23, 1973, at the Platte County Memorial Hospital following an extended illness.

Mrs. Nash had been a resident of Wheatland since 1917. She was born in Nebraska on September 3, 1890.

Mrs. Nash is survived by one son, Dwain Nash, San Marcos, Calif., and one daughter, Mrs. Perry Scranton, Wheatland.
